## Fact Sheet - AHO Tenants and Applicants

### My home – my lease – my repairs – what’s happening?

#### What’s happening?

You may have heard that, Family & Community Services (FACS) is moving the management of their tenants’ leases to a community housing provider in these locations:

- Northern Sydney District (*excluding Macquarie Park*) on Darug Country
- Mid North Coast District on Gumbaynggirr, Dunggutti, and Biripai Country
- Hunter New England (*excluding Lake Macquarie LGA and Newcastle LGA*) on Awabakal/Darokinjung, Worimi, and Kamilaroi Country
- Shoalhaven LGA on Tharawal Country.

#### I live in an Aboriginal Housing Office house. Will my tenancy be transferred?

No, FACS will still manage your lease, repairs to your home, and put you in touch with the services you need. For access to these services, contact FACS on 1800 422 322.

These transfers do not affect Aboriginal Housing Office tenants.

- You will continue to be managed by FACS.
- You will not have to move, and your rent and lease will stay the same.
